



INFORMATION AND CRITERIA FOR DASA SCHOLARSHIPS

The Dallas All Sports Association (DASA) Scholarship Program provides college scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 to \$4,000 to selected high school seniors or selected full-time college students that meet the following criteria:

Eligibility Criteria

- U.S. citizen for at least one year at time of application
- Current High School senior who is applying to or has been accepted to accredited 2 or 4 year college/university
- Current full-time college student enrolled in a full-time course of study at accredited 2 or 4 year college/university

Selection Criteria

- GPA of 3.0 or higher (4.0 scale)
- Demonstrated financial need (consideration of income and other scholarships, financial aid and grants)
- Overcoming challenges (educational, health, family and financial)
- Activities/Leadership
- Work history
- Sports program participation (recommended but not required)
- Completed application including high school or college transcript

Scholarship Awards

- Award amount: ranges from \$1,000 to \$4,000
- Scholarship funds are payable directly to the educational institution for tuition, fees, books, dorm, meal plan
- DASA does not distribute funds directly to students for personal or travel expenses

Application Guidelines

- Application period: September 1, 2018 through November 30, 2018
- Electronic applications available during application period on DASA website www.dallasallsports.org
- Electronic applications must be completed, e-mailed and received by the **November 30, 2018** deadline
- Applications must be COMPLETE, including high school or college transcript, financial information, essay and recommendation letters. (1st year college students who have not yet received their first semester grades are required to submit their high school transcript)
- Prior scholarship recipients are required to submit a complete application (with updated transcript) and may not rely on prior applications or prior transcripts

Scholarship Award Notification

- Scholarship winners will be notified by e-mail by 5pm on December 21, 2018
- Scholarship recipients may be recognized at an Awards Ceremony in December 2018 or January 2019

Prior Scholarship Recipients

- All applicants (new applicants and prior recipients) must maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and continued full-time enrollment. Prior scholarship recipients must complete a new application each year, and must provide updated transcripts showing completion of studies and updated GPA. Applications which are incomplete, or which do not include transcripts will not be considered.

Dallas All Sports Association Scholarship Application

The Applicant must be either 1) in the graduating class of a High School and applying to or accepted to an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university, or 2) the applicant must be a current full-time college student enrolled in a full-time course of study at an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university.

The schools may be public, private, or parochial. The applicant must demonstrate a financial need, academic achievement and leadership qualities. The applicant must attend an institution of continuing education to be eligible for this one-time scholarship award.

Letters of recommendation and a **copy of the applicant's high school and/or college transcript must be attached** to this application.
